Clothes

Dress code for the trip. First and foremost, **it is not necessary for anyone to purchase clothes they do not already possess**. Modest swimwear and shorts are required (no three-inch shorts). Tankini swimsuits are fine for girls, and boys should wear boxer, not brief style swim trunks. Anyone only possessed of a “skimpy” bathing suit can simply wear an old (colored) T-shirt or shorts over their swimsuit. Also, sneakers or some other form of close-toed shoes should be brought by everyone for the work project; we will be using tools. Jeans or other long pants are recommended for both the work project (we are in Pennsylvania, and poison ivy is always a hazard) and the evenings (it sometimes gets cool and mosquitoes are always an issue). Lastly, please remember that this is a combination of fun and work. You will get dirty nearly every day, so do not bring your best clothes. Think old and comfortable clothes, and you will be on the right track.
